No. 1976.—ORDER UNDER RULE 55 OF THE RULES UNDER “THE QUARANTINE AND PREVENTION OF DISEASE ENACTMENT, 1903.”—Information having been received that foot-and-mouth disease exists among cattle in Penang and Province Wellesley, the Resident of Perak, under rule 55 of the Rules under “The Quarantine and Prevention of Disease Enactment, 1903,” hereby prohibits the importation of cattle into the State of Perak from Penang and Province Wellesley until further notice.

No. 1977.—ORDER UNDER RULE 31 (i) OF THE RULES UNDER “THE QUARANTINE AND PREVENTION OF DISEASE ENACTMENT, 1903.”—Whereas it appears to the Resident of Perak that a disease—viz., cholera—exists near Lenggong, it is hereby ordered that all traffic except mail vehicles and Medical Department vehicles is prohibited between the 45th and 52nd mile-stones, Lenggong road, and between Randin and Pulau Kambing on the Perak river, until further notice.

No. 1978.—ORDER UNDER RULE 55 OF THE RULES UNDER “THE QUARANTINE AND PREVENTION OF DISEASE ENACTMENT, 1903.”—With reference to Notification No. 1174, published in the *Gazette Extraordinary* of the 18th April, 1914, it is hereby notified that the Resident of Selangor has modified his order prohibiting the importation of cattle into Selangor from Negapatam and Madras and has ordered that such cattle may be introduced into the State provided that they are accompanied by a certificate from a Veterinary Officer of the Government of India to the effect that they come from a district which has been free from disease for six months preceding the date of the certificate.
