No. 1917.—NOTICE TO LESSEES TO SHOW CAUSE WHY LEASE SHOULD NOT BE FORFEITED.—

To Lam Kam Wah and Lam Yin:

Whereas there is reason to believe that you have failed to employ for a period of more than twelve months the prescribed number of coolies on land, portion No. 32, in consequence whereof your lease No. 1,287, dated the 19th September, 1906, comprising the land following—namely:

Situation—Kalumpang. *Area*—20 acres 3 roods 15 poles;

has become liable to forfeiture; now, with the approval of the Resident of Selangor, I hereby call upon you, within one month from the service on you of this notice, to show cause to the satisfaction of the Resident why the said lease should not be forfeited.
