An Enactment to further amend the law relating to Trading with the Enemy.

[, 191 .]

President of the Federal Council.

It is hereby enacted by the Rulers of the Federated Malay States in Council as follows:

Short title, commencement and construction.

1. (i) This Enactment may be cited as "The Trading with the Enemy (Amendment) Enactment, 1916 (No. 2)," and shall come into force on the publication thereof in the *Gazette*.

(ii) This Enactment shall be read and construed as one with Enactment No. 3 of 1916, and any copies of the said Enactment printed after the commencement of this Enactment may be printed with the amendments made by this Enactment.

(iii) When "The Trading with the Enemy Enactments, 1914 to 1916" are cited, that expression shall include this Enactment.

2. Enactment No. 3 of 1916 is amended as follows:

Section 11.

(a) by the addition, immediately after section 11 (ii), of a new sub-section, numbered (ii) (a), as follows:

"(ii) (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of sub-sections (i) and (ii) hereof, no order shall be made by any Court authorizing the custodian to make, out of any money paid to or any property vested in him under this Enactment, any payment to any person of enemy nationality resident or carrying on business in any place not situated in the Federated Malay States or in the British Dominions."

(b) by the addition, immediately after section 17, of a new Section 18.
section, numbered 18, as follows:

- "18. (i) Prohibitions and restrictions, imposed by or under the provisions of any Enactment referred to in section 17 (iii), on exportation of goods shall apply to conveyance out of the Federated Malay States of goods which are brought in transit into any port of the Federated Malay States, whether they are landed for transshipment or not. Goods in transit.
- (ii) If any goods which are subject to such prohibition or restriction as aforesaid are found, in course of transit, on board of any vessel in any port of the Federated Malay States without lawful authority granted in the Federated Malay States in that behalf, such goods may be removed from such vessel and such vessel may be detained till such goods have been removed.
- (iii) Such goods may be forfeited by order of the Chief Secretary to Government and may be destroyed or otherwise disposed of as the Chief Secretary to Government directs."

OBJECTS AND REASONS.

The object of this Bill is two-fold. In the first place, when read with Enactment No. 3 of 1916, it provides that no claims made by enemy subjects resident or carrying on business in places not situated in the Federated Malay States or in the British Dominions shall be paid out of funds in the possession of the custodian of enemy property, save only under the licence of the Chief Secretary to Government.

In the second place, since doubts exist as to whether prohibitions and restrictions imposed by Enactments relating to trading with the enemy on the exportation of goods extend to the conveyance out of the Federated Malay States of goods brought in transit into the Federated Malay States, this Bill applies all such prohibitions and restrictions to goods so brought in transit.

ENACTMENT No. OF 191 .

An Enactment to amend “The Arms Enactment, 1915.”

[, 191 .]

President of the Federal Council.

IT is hereby enacted by the Rulers of the Federated Malay States in Council as follows:

Short title,
commencement
and
construction.

1. (i) This Enactment may be cited as “The Arms Enactment, 1915, Amendment Enactment, 191 .,” and shall come into force on the publication thereof in the *Gazette*.

No. 13 of 1915.

(ii) This Enactment shall be read and construed as one with “The Arms Enactment, 1915,” hereinafter called “the principal Enactment,” and any copies of the said Enactment printed after the commencement of this Enactment may be printed with the amendments made by this Enactment.

Amendment of
section 4 (ii).

2. Sub-section (ii) of section 4 of the principal Enactment is amended by deleting from lines 1 and 2 the words “after the thirty-first day of January in any year”.

New section 4A.

3. Immediately after section 4 of the principal Enactment there is inserted a new section, to be numbered 4A, as follows:

Period of
exemption in
certain cases.

“4A. No person shall be deemed guilty of any contravention of this Enactment or of any rule thereunder by reason only of the fact that during the month of January in any year he has in his possession or custody any arms in respect of which no licence or permit is in force; provided that such person had such arms in his possession or custody on the thirty-first day of December of the preceding year under a licence or permit issued in that behalf under this Enactment.”

OBJECTS AND REASONS.

As the law now stands, a person who, during the month of January in any year, has in his possession arms in respect of which no licence or permit issued under “The Arms Enactment, 1915,” is in force is liable to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars. If this offence is committed during any other month in the year, the penalty extends to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three years. The objects of this amendment are: (a) to exempt from all liability the unlicensed possession during the month of January in any year of arms in respect of which a licence or permit issued under the said Enactment expired on the 31st December of the preceding year; and (b) to attach to the unlicensed possession during the month of January in any year of arms in respect of which there was no such former licence or permit the same liability as is imposed by the Enactment upon unlicensed possession during any other month in the year.

“(ii) With the previous approval of the Resident in each case the Conservator may from time to time, if it appears to him desirable in the public interest to expedite the removal of forest produce generally or of any specified kind of forest produce from any area, order that royalty be levied on all or any specified kind of forest produce removed from such area at a rate or rates lower than the rate or rates prescribed under these rules, provided that no such order shall continue in force for a longer period than two years.”
