No. 2544.—“THE PUBLIC EMERGENCY ENACTMENT, 1914.”

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by “The Public Emergency Enactment, 1914,” the High Commissioner did, by Notification No. 3494, published in the *Gazette* on the 26th November, 1915, prohibit the exportation from the Federated Malay States to the Netherlands of all articles except certain articles mentioned in the said notification :

AND WHEREAS the list of articles so excepted was, by Notification No. 3805, published in the *Gazette* on the 21st December, 1915, amended so as to include Tobacco :

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that the notification whereby Tobacco was added to the list of excepted articles should be revoked :

NOW IT IS HEREBY NOTIFIED that His Excellency, in virtue and exercise of the powers aforesaid, rescinds the said Notification No. 3805 of the 21st December, 1915.
