No. 2543.—Customs Duties Enactment.—For the period from the 18th to 24th August, 1916, inclusive, the value of the highest grade of rubber is fixed at two shillings and two pence three-quarter penny per lb., and the duty on cultivated rubber on which export duty is leviable on an ad valorem basis in accordance with the Rules under the Customs Duties Enactment, will be assessed on a price of \$115 per pikul for all grades.
