FEDERATED MALAY STATES.

REPORT OF THE DIRECTORS OF THE PUBLIC OFFICERS' GUARANTEE FUND, FEDERATED MALAY STATES, FOR THE YEAR 1915.

1. In accordance with section 8 of "The Public Officers' Guarantee Fund Enactment, No. 11 of 1913," we have the honour to report on the financial position of the Fund for the year ending 31st December, 1915.

2. The entrance fees amounted to \$953.50 and contributions to \$11,423.69 as compared with \$1,659.71 and \$11,573.56 of 1914.

3. The interest on fixed deposits amounted to \$4,170.98 as against \$3,972.94 in 1914. The increase is due to the amounts of some of the deposits being increased from cash balances. A sum of £10,000 was invested in $4\frac{1}{2}$ per cent. War Loan Stock and the interest received thereon during the year was \$1,644.46; the cost of the Stock was \$85,255.64.

4. At the end of the year the Fund stood security for 4,892 officers to the amount of \$2,366,974.

5. The amount paid on account of defalcations during the year 1915 was \$6,125.80.

6. The total amount paid in respect of defalcations since the Fund was established is \$18,947.28:

8. The accounts have been audited and a copy of the audited balance sheet is annexed. It will be observed that at the end of the year the Government had advanced the Fund a sum of \$55,222.05 : this advance has since been adjusted.

9. During the year the Directors suffered the loss of Mr. Pugh's services through his death. Mr. Candiah, who had been Secretary for nearly four years, also retired on pension.
