"MINING ENACTMENT, 1899."

Rule under section 113 (i.) of the above-mentioned Enactment, made by the Resident, with the approval of the Resident-General, on the 30th day of December, 1902, and published in the Gazette, on the 2nd day of January, 1903.

Subject to any special instructions by the Resident, given with the sanction of the Resident-General in exceptional cases, the quitrent payable under section 12 (i.) of the above Enactment shall, until further notice, be at the rate of \$1 per acre or part of an acre, and shall be payable in advance without demand on the 1st day of January in each year at the Land Office of the district in which the land is situated.
