NO. 32.—CHINESE NEW YEAR.—With the sanction of the Resident the Chief Police Officer has, under section 4 of the “Small Offences Enactment, 1898,” fixed the under-mentioned dates and hours during which fireworks may be let off in public:

From 6 p.m. on Wednesday, 28th January, to 6 a.m. on Thursday, 29th January.

From 6 p.m. to midnight, on Thursday, 29th January.

From 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Friday, 30th January.

From 6 a.m. to 8 a.m. on Wednesday, 4th February.

From 6 p.m. on Thursday, 5th February, to 6 a.m. on Friday, 6th February.

From 6 a.m. to 8 a.m. and from 6 p.m. to 10 p.m. on Thursday, 12th February.

The firing of bombs is prohibited.
