ORDINANCE No. XXXV. of 1902.

AN ORDINANCE FURTHER TO AMEND THE PENAL CODE.

F. A. SWETTENHAM,

[28th November, 1902.7

Governor and Commander-in-Chief.

It is hereby enacted by the Governor of the Straits Settlements with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :-

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Penal Code Amendment ordinance No. II 1902". It shall be read and construed as one with the Penal Code and any copy of the Penal Code printed after the commencement of the Ordinance may be printed with the amendments alterations and omissions made and required by this Ordinance.

2. Section 356 of the Penal Code as amended by "The Penal Code Amendment of Section 356 of the Penal Code as amended by omitting the Section 356 of the Penal Code, words "or with all" after the words "or with whipping."

3. Section 392 of the Penal Code as amended by "The Penal Code Amendment Ordinance 1902" is further amended by omitting the words "and to whipping" after the words "liable to fine" and by inserting after the words "sunset and sunrise" the words "he shall also be liable to whipping and" be liable to whipping and."
