Workshop | Habits of Happy Lecturer

On 2 & 3 August 2017, ADeC organised a workshop under the Leadership and Wellbeing unit, on "Habits of Happy Lecturers". Trainers including En. Marzuki, Dr. Rozita Shaary (both are certified Neuro-Semantics and NLP Trainer), and LeadWell's Head of Unit, Dr. Amira Firdaus (who also holds a Beginners Level Certification in Meta-Coaching). It was full of engaging sessions and hands-on activities on emphasizing happiness in career.



Basic Course in Supervision

This two-day seminar that disseminates information about supervisory and postgraduate research candidacy processes and procedures, as well as imparts skills and strategies for supervising student research.



Basic Course in Teaching and Learning
