CREATING ACADEMIC AND TEACHING PORTFOLIO

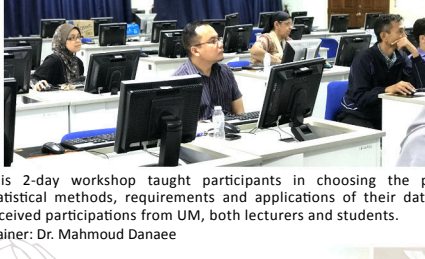
