

# FIRST GATHERING OF INTERNATIONAL LEADING BIOTECHNOLOGY AND GENOMICS EXPERTS IN UM



UM, 28 February 2019 (Monday): The Inaugural Eminent Speakers Conference Series held at the Auditorium, Research Management & Innovation Complex, UM was co-organised by Faculty of Medicine, UM and Genting Berhad in conjunction with the Genting Founder's Day.

It is the first time, Malaysia bring together four eminent speakers from the world's foremost, award winning researchers and experts to share their insights on the latest approaches in medical science with respect to healthy ageing, through early detection and novel treatments in an event entitled 'Navigating Towards Healthy Ageing'.

Tan Sri Lim Kok Thay, Chairman and Chief **Executive of Genting Berhad said during his** opening speech at the conference, "Over the past decade, Genting Berhad has been involved in research and development for new treatments and new ways for early detection of diseases through our investments in life sciences and biotechnology companies. San Diego, started the conference with his
talk titled 'Integration of Quantitative
Imaging and Genetics for Proactive
Medicine'. The second speaker was the only
Malaysian speaker at the conference, Prof.





Dr. Ng Kwan Hoong, Professor of Medical Physics, University of Malaya. The third speaker was Prof. Dr. Claude M. Wischik, Holder of the Chair in Mental Health, University of Aberdeen, and Executive Chairman of TauRx Pharmaceuticals Limited. The final speaker was Dr Robert J. Hariri who is a surgeon, biomedical scientist, and a highly successful serial entrepreneur.

The talk was followed by a panel discussion, where the public took the opportunity to pose questions to the panelist comprising Prof. Dato' Dr. Adeeba Kamarulzaman and the four speakers. Prof. Dr. Tan Maw Pin from the Faculty of Medicine, UM facilitated the panel discussion as the moderator.

As part of the conference, the Malaysian Prime Minister YAB Tun Dr Mahathir Mohammad who epitomizes healthy ageing, held a dialogue with the speakers, and representatives from Genting Berhad and University of Malaya to discuss medical advances and exchange ideas on healthy ageing.

Also in attendance during the conference were Datuk IR. (Dr.) Abdul Rahim Haji Hashim, Vice-Chancellor UM, Prof. Dato' Dr Adeeba Kamarulzaman, Dean of Faculty of Medicine, UM, members of the life science and medical fraternity, students and the general public.

# BELANJAWAN KU EXPENDITURE GUIDE FOR MALAYSIAN INDIVIDUALS & FAMILIES









Belanjawanku is an expenditure guide to provide estimated minimum monthly expenses on various types of goods and services for different households in Malaysia in effort to assist Malaysians to plan for their personal and family budgeting to achieve a reasonable standard of living.

The Belanjawanku project was commissioned by the Employees Provident Fund (EPF) under its financial literacy program and the detailed research was done by Social Wellbeing Research Centre (SWRC) of University of Malaya led by its Director, Emeritus Professor Datuk Dr Norma Mansor.

Low financial literacy, rising cost of living, and over-indebtedness among Malaysians have been the main reasons to develop Belanjawanku to serve as a practical reference and foundation for money management. A survey and focus group discussions comprising of researchers from local universities, representatives from the EPF, Credit Counselling and Debt Management Agency (AKPK), Economic Planning Unit, the National Wage Council, NGOs, Bank Negara Malaysia, and experts from industries, which include financial institutions, financial planners, nutritionists and reference persons of

specific households residing in Klang Valley were conducted in the research.

**Retirement Advisory Service (RAS) officers in** EPF will be using the Belanjawanku to provide its members financial guidance and advice, complementing its existing services. **EPF Chief Executive Officer Tunku Alizakri** Alias expects Belanjawanku to form the bedrock of strong financial wellbeing, leading to a better quality of life in the long term. Belanjawanku will be routinely updated to reflect the change in prices, with



versions exclusive to other regions to follow. University Malaya Vice-Chancellor Datuk Ir. (Dr.) Abdul Rahim Hj. Hashim points out that Belanjawanku as expenditure guide is useful as a cost of living indicator as well as a guide for Malaysians to improve personal financial management and lead a happy and meaningful life. Belanjawanku is expected to be contributing to the social security infrastructure and act as a reference to measure the effectiveness of policy changes while assessing the impact of outside events on Malaysian living standards.
