#### Resit Pinjaman

Perpustakaan Universiti Malaya telah memperkenalkan satu lagi inovasi dalam mempermudah urusan pinjaman buku di perpustakaan. Buat pertama kalinya, resit pinjaman diperkenalkan di kaunter perkhidmatan di Perpustakaan Utama serta perpustakaan cawangan yang lain. Resit pinjaman ini menggantikan sistem terdahulu yang digunakan iaitu cop tarikh tamat tempoh pinjaman di mana ianya tidak lagi dipraktikkan. Penggunaan resit pinjaman ini selain daripada lebih praktikal ianya juga lebih kemas dan bersih.

Resit pinjaman ini mengandungi maklumat pengguna serta maklumat bahan yang dipinjam beserta tarikh tamat tempoh pinjaman bahan tersebut. Ia dikeluarkan di kaunter perkhidmatan sebaik sahaja proses pinjaman berkomputer selesai dilakukan. Resit ini perlu disimpan oleh pengguna sebagai bukti pinjaman selain berperanan sebagai peringatan kepada pengguna mengenai tarikh pemulangan bahan atau sekiranya hendak memperbaharui pinjaman.

#### Borrowing Receipt

*The University of Malaya Library has introduced another innovation to simplify the borrowing process. For the first time, borrowing receipt will be used at the Main Library and also branch libraries. This receipt replaces the previous manual system which is no longer in practice. The use of receipt is more practical and neat.*

*The borrowing receipt consists of user information and borrowing details with due date for each material. Receipt will be issued by the service counter immediately after the computerized borrowing process is completed. A user must keep the receipt as borrowing evidence and also as a reminder for them to return or renew the item.*

*I would like to access NSTP e-media. How can I do this?*

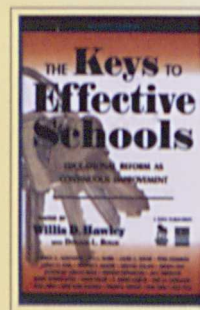
*NSTP e-media is a fee-based service. In order to download the full text of any article in NSTP e-media, a user has to request personally from the Reference Librarian.*
