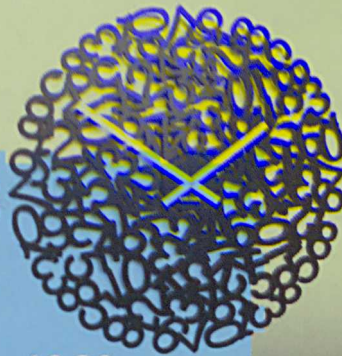

(Overdue Fine: RM 0.10 per day)

2 items / 14 days
