No. 3331.— “THE POST OFFICE ENACTMENTS, 1905.”

IN exercise of the powers vested in him by “The Post Office Enactments, 1905,” and by way of amendment of rule 2 made under the said Enactments on the 21st September, 1907, and published in the *Perak, Selangor, Negri Sembilan and Pahang Government Gazettes* on the 1st day of October, 1907, the Chief Secretary to Government hereby directs that on and from the 27th October, 1916, the postage on letters addressed to the places in China at which British Post Offices are maintained, with the exception of Weihaiwei, shall be 8 cents for any weight not exceeding one ounce and 5 cents for every additional ounce or part thereof. The postage on letters addressed to the British Postal Agency at Weihaiwei shall continue to be 4 cents for each ounce or part of an ounce.
