“THE QUARANTINE AND PREVENTION OF DISEASE ENACTMENT, 1903.”

No. 3906.—Rinderpest having ceased to exist in Selangor, the Resident of Perak hereby rescinds Notification No. 3211 of the 13th October, 1916.

“THE RAILWAYS ENACTMENT, 1912.”

No. 3907.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 27 of “The Railways Enactment, 1912,” and with the approval of the Chief Secretary to Government, the Railway Administration hereby rescinds rule 23, clauses (a), (b) and (c), of the Tariff Rules, published as Notification No. 2 in the *Federated Malay States Government Gazette* of the 1st January, 1916, and substitutes the following therefor, to take effect from the 1st March, 1917:

23. PASSENGER FARES.—

(a) Passenger fares by train—

First class	7½ cents per mile
Second „	4½ „ „
Third „	3 „ „

(b) Passenger fares by launch between Johore Bharu and Woodlands—

First class	15 cents
Second „	12 „
Third „	7 „

(c) Passenger fares by launch between Prai and Penang—

First class	22 cents
Second „	15 „
Third „	7 „
