No. 8.—APPOINTMENT OF REGISTRAR UNDER THE "JINRIKISHA ENACTMENT, 1900."—In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 3 of the "Jinrikisha Enactment, 1900," the Sanitary Boards of Larut and Matang, Parit Buntar, Kinta North, Kinta South, Kuala Kangsar, Upper Perak, Lower Perak and Batang Padang have appointed Mr. James Rigby, Registrar of Vehicles, to be a Registrar of Jinrikishas in and for their respective Sanitary Board areas, with effect from the 1st January, 1910.

No. 9.—APPOINTMENT OF MAGISTRATE.—In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 8 (i) of "The Courts Enactment, 1905," the Resident of the State of Perak has been pleased to appoint the Registrar of Vehicles to be a Magistrate of the Second Class in and for the State of Perak, with effect from the 1st January, 1910.

No. 10.—CULTIVATION OF LALANG WASTES.—It is hereby notified that in future the rate of quit-rent to be charged for lalang land in the State of Perak will be the same as for other agricultural land, but that no premium will be charged thereon.

No. 13.—ORDER UNDER THE “BANISHMENT ENACTMENT, 1900.”—Whereas it appears to His Highness the Sultan of Perak that the removal from the State of the persons enumerated in the schedule hereto is necessary for the public safety and welfare :

It is hereby ordered by His Highness the Sultan, with the advice and consent of the Resident, that the said persons so enumerated shall be, and they are hereby, banished from the State, for the period of their natural lives.

No. 14.—STORAGE OF PETROLEUM, SELANGOR.—Whereas under Section 10 (ii) of the “Petroleum Enactment, 1897,” the Resident of the State of Selangor is empowered to make, and when made to vary and revoke, rules for the storage of dangerous petroleum, it is hereby ordered by the Resident that the operation of Rule 22A, published in the *Selangor Government Gazette*, Notification No. 413 of the 30th July, 1909, be suspended until further notice.

No. 15.—“THE FEDERAL RUBBER DEALERS ENACTMENT, 1909.”—By virtue of the powers conferred upon him by section 2 of “The Federal Rubber Dealers Enactment, 1909,” the Resident of the State of Negri Sembilan has been pleased to appoint the Collector of Land Revenue, Seremban, to be the Licensing Officer for the District of Seremban.

“THE RAILWAYS ENACTMENT, 1903.”

AMENDMENT of Rule relating to Steam Tug and Tongkang Charges at Port Swettenham, made on the 1st day of January, 1910.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 25 of “The Railways Enactment, 1903,” the General Manager of the Federated Malay States Government Railways, with the approval of the Resident-General, hereby amends clause (r) of the Rule headed “Special Class Rates,” made under the said section and published in the States of Perak, Selangor, Negri Sembilan and Pahang as a Supplement to the *Gazettes* of 19th April, 12th April, 19th April, and 1st May, 1907, respectively, by deleting paragraph (iii) thereof and substituting therefor the following paragraph :

(iii) The charges for use of Railway tongkangs at Port Swettenham within a radius of one mile from the Railway Passenger Jetty, including towage by steam tug, will be as follows :

For discharge of general cargo, \$5 per loaded trip ; this charge will not be made to ocean-going steamers which by reason of their deep draught cannot get alongside a Railway wharf to discharge general cargo.

For lightering of rough and mineral class traffic, such as bricks, cinders, clay, coal, coke, compressed fuel, gravel, ore in bulk, salt in bulk, sand, scrap iron in bulk, stone in bulk, tiles and other similar traffic, \$15 for each tongkang per day of 24 hours or part thereof, to be calculated from the time when the tongkang leaves the shore. After the expiration of 24 hours demurrage will be charged at the rate of \$5 for every 24 hours or part thereof until the tongkang is unloaded and released. The loading and unloading is to be performed by the hirer of the tongkang.
