“THE QUARANTINE AND PREVENTION OF DISEASE ENACTMENT, 1903.”

No. 145.—Rinderpest having ceased to exist in Siam, the Resident of Perak hereby rescinds Notifications Nos. 1140, 2176, and 2383, of the 21st March, 31st May, and 13th June, 1919, respectively.

No. 146.—Rinderpest having ceased to exist in Siam, the Resident of Negri Sembilan hereby rescinds Notification No. 1547 of the 17th April, 1919.

No. 147.—Rinderpest having ceased to exist at Gedong Lallang in the Seremban district, the Resident of Negri Sembilan hereby rescinds Notification No. 4344, published in the *Gazette* of the 31st October, 1919.
