**No. 599.**—Sir Laurence Nunns Guillemard, K.C.B., arrived in the Colony of the Straits Settlements on 3rd February, 1920, took the Oaths of Allegiance and Office, and assumed the duties of Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Straits Settlements, and of High Commissioner, Federated Malay States, on the same day, as notified in the *Straits Settlements Gazette* Notification No. 211 of the 3rd February, 1920, hereinafter quoted.

“His Excellency Sir Laurence Nunns Guillemard, Knight Commander of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, having arrived in this Colony, this day presented a Commission from His Majesty the King appointing him to be Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Straits Settlements, which having been duly read and published, the Oaths of Allegiance and of Office were administered to His Excellency by the Hon'ble the Chief Justice of the Straits Settlements, in the Council Chamber at Singapore, in the presence of the Members of the Executive and Legislative Councils, Public Officers, and others, and thereupon His Excellency assumed the Government, and all persons are hereby required to take notice accordingly.”
