ST. JAMES'S PALACE.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR WEARING BADGES ROUND THE NECK BY THE POSSESSORS  
OF THE INSIGNIA OF MORE THAN ONE ORDER WHICH IS SO WORN.

Only one Ribbon and Badge, i.e., the *senior one*, is worn round the neck inside and under the Collar of the Uniform Coat, so that the Badge hangs about an inch outside and below the front of the Collar. All other Badges are worn, one below the other, commencing about an inch below the senior badge, each suspended on about three inches of ribbon emerging from between the buttons of the Uniform Coat. A small eye is stitched inside the coat to which the ribbon is fastened by a hook.

In Evening Dress, one Badge only is worn round the neck, and as a rule the *senior badge* is thus worn, unless a junior one should appear to be more appropriate to the occasion. The ribbon, from which this badge is suspended, is worn under the white tie, the badge hanging about an inch below. All badges are worn also, *in Miniature*, on the lapel of the coat.

These instructions will not affect the existing regulations with regard to the wearing of Insignia, *in Miniature*, by Naval and Military Officers.

No. 606.—The following Bill about to be introduced in the Federal Council is published for general information:

A BILL  
*intituled*

An Enactment to amend "The Extradition Enactment, 1914."

IT is hereby enacted by the Rulers of the Federated Malay States in Council as follows:

Short title,  
commencement  
and construc-  
tion.

1. (i) This Enactment may be cited as "The Extradition Enactment, 1914, Amendment Enactment, 1920," and shall come into force on the publication thereof in the *Gazette*.

(ii) This Enactment shall be read and construed as one with "The Extradition Enactment, 1914," hereinafter called the "principal Enactment," and any copies of the principal Enactment printed after the commencement of this Enactment may be printed with the amendments made by this Enactment.

Amendment of  
section 2.

2. Section 2 of the principal Enactment is amended by inserting in the interpretation of Diplomatic Representative of a foreign country, next after the words "person recognized", the words "by the High Commissioner or".

Amendment  
section 7.

3. Section 7 of the principal Enactment is amended by inserting next after the words "made to", in line 6, the words "the High Commissioner or", and by substituting for the words "the Chief Secretary", in line 7, the words "the High Commissioner or the Chief Secretary, as the case may be".

OBJECTS AND REASONS.

The Extradition Enactment, 1914, contemplates that requisitions for the surrender of fugitive criminals who have entered the Federated Malay States will be addressed by foreign countries to a Resident or to the Chief Secretary to Government; but the extension of certain Extradition Treaties to the Federated Malay States has been arranged by His Majesty's Government on the understanding, in effect, that such requisitions will be addressed to the High Commissioner. There are objections to altering these arrangements; at the same time requisitions addressed to the High Commissioner might be held not to satisfy the requirements of our law, as it now stands, and be thereby rendered abortive. To obviate risk of this, the present amending Bill has been framed.

**No. 769.**—Minutes of an ordinary meeting of the Kinta Sanitary Board held at Ipoh on Wednesday, the 21st January, 1920.

**PRESENT:** Mr. C. F. J. Green (*Chairman*), the Health Officer, Kinta (Dr. H. M. C. Green), the Chief Police Officer, Perak (Mr. G. S. Magill), the Chief Assistant District Officer, Kinta (Mr. A. J. Sturrock), the Executive Engineer, Kinta (Mr. E. L. Bennett), the Acting Deputy Superintendent, Revenue Surveys, Kinta (Mr. J. T. Wood), Mr. H. J. Cooper, Towkay Chan Heang Thoy, J.P., Towkay Thong Lim Seng, and Mr. V. Sengal Rayen Naidu.

**ABSENT:** The Protector of Chinese, Perak (Mr. T. W. H. Kingston), the Assistant Commissioner of Police, Kampar (Mr. D. M. Barry), the Hon. Mr. R. P. Brash, J.P., Mr. F. E. de Paula, and Datoh Abdul Wahab, J.P.

1. The minutes of the last ordinary meeting are taken as read and confirmed, the approval of the Resident being noted.

2. The monthly returns for December are circulated.

The principal figures of revenue and expenditure, work at the abattoirs, and the cost of lighting are:

3. The public works expenditure in Sanitary Board areas up to the end of December is returned as \$129,868.30, of which \$79,629.14 is for roads, etc., and \$35,033.08 for the upkeep of waterworks.

4. The return of weights and measures, registers of prosecutions and plans passed are laid on the table and approved.

6. Report by the Geologist, Federated Malay States, on an Overhanging Limestone Cliff near the Marble Quarries, Ipoh: The Board consider that the matter primarily affects the railway and the Chairman is requested to ask that the Board be informed as to what the Railway Department propose to do.

7. High Prices of Food-stuffs: The Chairman reads the replies of the Resident and the Food Controller regarding the control of prices of food-stuffs, the Controller being of the opinion that "to control the supply and import of articles all over the country would at present be undesirable as well as unnecessary." The Board agree to Mr. H. J. Cooper forming a Committee, of which he is to be the Chairman, the Committee to be composed of members of the Board, and to recommend to the Board the steps to be taken to control prices of articles of food in the Kinta markets. The Committee is further to take active part in the administration of the markets as far as is necessary for the control of prices.

8. Upkeep of Ipoh Road Verges: The Board agree to ask the Executive Engineer, as a start, to employ a gang of ten coolies and a tindal to keep the grass borders within road reserves trim and clear of rubbish on both sides of the road ditches, and to report after a time on the progress made. It was suggested that a start be made on the Kuala Kangsar Road to the Tambun Road and road to the Golf Course.

9. Continuation of Present System of Food Control throughout 1920: On the instructions of Government the Food Controller's letter of 19th December, 1919, is laid before the Board. On the proposal of Mr. J. T. Wood, seconded by Mr. Chan Heang Thoy, the Board agree that Government be requested to import unsifted mealie meal—which is the food of the Kaffirs in Africa—instead of the refined quality for the use of coolies. The Board also agree to Mr. Cooper's suggestion that trial depôts be opened by Government at convenient centres, where surplus crops from estates may be sent to for disposal.

10. Application from Mr. D. W. F. Hatelie to Construct a Motor Repair Shop on Land in Brewster Road opposite the Fire Station: The Board decide not to allow such workshops in Brewster Road.

11. Proposed Motor Show Room on Plan 11,104, Brewster Road: The Board decide to inform the Cycle and Carriage Co. that the plans returned for amendment must provide for the doors opening on to Brewster Road being of a width which would not permit of the passage of motor cars.

12. Alienation of Nine Acres of Land at Kampar for proposed Cheap Dwellings to be erected by the Hon. Mr. Eu Tong Sen: The Board recommend a 99 years' lease subject to the condition, that the rents of the houses to be erected are to be approved of and controlled by the Board.

13. Planting of Rubber Trees within Sanitary Board Limits: The question of legislation to prohibit such planting is discussed. In view of section 23 of Enactment No. 42 of 1918, which came into force on 12th February, 1919, the Board are of opinion that no further legislation is necessary.

14. Petition from Poultry Dealers: It is decided to refer to the Committee to be formed by Mr. Cooper the petition asking that the control prices on fowls and ducks be removed.

15. Application from Lux Lamp-lighters for Increase of Wages: The Board agree to raise existing rates by 10 cents per diem.

16. Scenery for Ipoh Town Hall: The Resident's minute is noted but the Chairman is requested to make further representations, as a vote entered for 1921 will mean having to wait nearly two years before the scenery arrives. The Chairman suggests and the Board agree, that the stage requirements of the Town Hall be looked after by a Committee composed of Mr. Cooper and three or four others to be chosen by him, not necessarily from the Members of the Board.

17. New Town Hall for Ipoh: The Resident's minute is noted on the subject of a suggestion to construct a new Town Hall and convert the present building into offices for one or more Government Departments.

18. The Board adjourns *sine die*.

#### No. 770.—SANITARY BOARD, KUALA LUMPUR.—

Minutes of an ordinary meeting of the Sanitary Board, Kuala Lumpur, held at the Sanitary Board Office on Wednesday, the 31st December, 1919, at 9.30 a.m.

PRESENT: Mr. F. E. Taylor (*Chairman*), the Protector of Chinese (Mr. W. T. Chapman), the Executive Engineer, Town (Mr. J. A. Swift), Towkay Choo Kia Peng, Towkay Khoo Keng Hooi, and Haji Mohamed Taib.

ABSENT: The Health Officer (Dr. A. R. Wellington), the Chief Police Officer (Mr. H. M. Hatchell), the Superintendent, Revenue Surveys (Mr. H. R. Shaw), the Assistant Government Architect (Mr. W. S. Huxley), the Collector of Land Revenue (Mr. G. Hemmant), Mr. J. L. Sime, Mr. H. N. Ferrers, and Dr. E. T. MacIntyre.

1. Minutes of the previous meeting, having been circulated among the members, are taken as read, and confirmed.

2. The Board, with the concurrence of the Health Officer, agrees to allow a lane 14 feet wide in rear of premises to be erected on lots 28 and 29, section 9, Kuala Lumpur, and to recommend that one-half the width of the lane be considered as part of the open area of the buildings referred to.

3. Plans, Notices, Prosecutions, etc.:

The following are approved:

- (a) Nine plans as per register;
- (b) One application for water supply as per register;
- (c) Sixty-five notices and 45 applications for prosecution;
- (d) Progress report, Executive Engineer, Town, for month of November, 1919.

4. Health Report: The Health Officer's report on the health of Kuala Lumpur for the month of November, 1919, is submitted:

(1) The population for the middle of November, 1919, is estimated at 66,916.

(2) Births: During the month, 120 births were notified, giving an uncorrected birth-rate of 21.52 per mille.

(3) Deaths: The total number of deaths registered as having occurred within the Sanitary Board limits was 189, giving a crude death-rate of 33.89 per mille. The number of deaths among the resident population was 132, giving a corrected death-rate of 23.67 per mille. The corrected death-rate for the corresponding month of 1918 was 33.63 per mille. There were 30 deaths of infants under the age of one year. The infantile mortality figure (deaths under one year of age per 1,000 births) was 250.

(4) The diseases causing the greatest number of deaths were:

(5) Infectious Diseases: Three cases of typhoid (enteric fever), one case of measles and one case of diphtheria were reported.

(6) The total rainfall recorded at the General Hospital for the month was 324 m.m. The greatest fall for the 24 hours ending 6 p.m. was 99.8 m.m. on the 29th. There was no recorded fall for 11 days. The mean temperatures for the month were: 9 a.m., 80.97 degrees; 3 p.m., 83.83 degrees; 9 p.m., 76.23 degrees. The maximum temperature was 90 degrees on the 1st, 4th, 15th, 17th, 18th, 19th, 20th, 21st and 24th, and the lowest was 70 degrees on the 3rd, 10th, 16th, 18th, 21st, 22nd and 27th.

(7) Ten samples of milk were sent to the Government Chemist for analysis during the month, one of which was found to be adulterated.

5. Mr. Choo Kia Peng suggests, in view of the increase of vehicular traffic brought about by the reconstruction of the Marshalling Yard at Brickfields Road, that the railway authorities be asked to widen the bridge over the railway between Brickfields Road and Bungsar Road. The Board agrees.

6. On the suggestion of Mr. Khoo Keng Hooi, the Board agrees to provide more space in the Theatre Street Market for pork stalls by transferring the sellers of beef, vegetables, etc., to the central market as soon as accommodation is available; also to set apart a number of pork stalls in the Theatre Street Market for the exclusive use of Hokiens.

7. On the suggestion of Mr. Choo Kia Peng, it is decided to call for a report from the Health Officer regarding the pork butchers shops in High Street and Petaling Street, with a view to introducing similar shops in other localities.
