THE CUSTOMS DUTIES ENACTMENTS, 1897 AND 1898.

No. 947.—In exercise of the powers in them severally invested by the Customs Duties Enactments, 1898, of Perak, Selangor and Pahang, and the Customs Duties Enactment, 1897, of Negri Sembilan, the Residents of Perak, Selangor, Negri Sembilan and Pahang, each for the State whereof he is Resident, with the approval of the Chief Secretary to Government, hereby amend, with effect from the 8th day of March, 1920, Notification No. 28 of January 3rd, 1919, as follows:

After the words "For the purposes of this Notification one gallon of latex shall be taken as equivalent to one pound of rubber", insert a comma, and add the words "and bark shavings from rubber trees shall be taken to contain 20 per cent. by weight of rubber".

RESCISSION OF ORDERS RELATING TO IMPORTATION OF DOGS INTO SELANGOR.

No. 948.—It is hereby notified that the orders made by the Resident of Selangor, published as Notifications No. 3835 of the 23rd December, 1918, and No. 1917 of the 14th May, 1919, prohibiting the importation of dogs into Selangor from the Settlement of Malacca and the State of Negri Sembilan have been rescinded.

No. 949.—The Food Control Regulations, 1918.—

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by regulation 6 of the Food Control Regulations, 1918, the Food Controller hereby fixes the maximum prices, as per schedule annexed, for the sale of Nestle's Milkmaid Sweetened Milk: \$23.00 a case

By importers 23.15 By wholesale dealers 23.50

By retail dealers or when sold in less quantity than one case 49 cents a tin.

2. Provided that where the above-mentioned brand of milk is sold or offered for sale in the States of Perak, 2. Provided that where the above-mentioned states of Perak, Selangor, Negri Sembilan and Pahang in any shop or place not situate within the Samitary Board or village limits Selangor, Negri Sembilan and Panang in any shop of part as a state which such brand is permitted to be sold or offered for of any town or village having a railway station, the price at which such brand is permitted to be sold or offered for

3. For the purposes of this Order the words "case" and "tin" shall bear the meanings assigned to them respectively by Notification No. 955, published in the Gazette on 5th March, 1919.

4. (i) This Order may be cited as the Price of Milk Order No. 2 of 1920. (ii) This Order shall apply generally throughout the Federated Malay States.

(iii) This Order shall have effect as from 3rd March, 1920. (iii) This Order shall have elect as Holl of the Cazette on 6th December, (iv) The Price of Milk Order No. 2 of 1919, published as Notification No. 5026 in the Gazette on 6th December,

1919, is hereby cancelled.
