PRESENT :

THE KING'S MOST EXCELLENT MAJESTY IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by the Termination of the Present War (Definition) Act, 1918, it is provided that His Majesty in Council may declare what date is to be treated as the date of the termination of the present war, and that the date so declared shall be as nearly as may be the date of the exchange or deposit of ratifications of the treaty or treaties of peace, and that His Majesty may also similarly declare what date is to be treated as the date of the termination of war between His Majesty and any particular State :

AND WHEREAS at Versailles on the twenty-eighth day of June, nineteen hundred and nineteen, a treaty of peace between the Allied and Associated Powers and Germany was signed on behalf of His Majesty :

AND WHEREAS by the said treaty of peace it was provided that a procès-verbal of the deposit of ratifications should be drawn up as soon as the treaty had been ratified by Germany on the one hand and by three of the principal Allied or Associated Powers on the other, and that from the date of the said procès-verbal the treaty would come into force between the high contracting parties who had ratified it :

AND WHEREAS the said treaty having been ratified by Germany and three of the principal Allied and Associated Powers, including His Majesty, such a procès-verbal as aforesaid has been drawn up dated the tenth day of January, nineteen hundred and twenty :

AND WHEREAS treaties of peace with other belligerents not having yet been ratified it is desirable to declare the date which is to be treated as the date of the termination of war with Germany before declaring the date which is to be treated as the date of the termination of the present war :

NOW, THEREFORE, His Majesty, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, is pleased to order, and it is hereby ordered, that the said tenth day of January shall be treated as the date of the termination of war between His Majesty and Germany.

No. 1486.—SANITARY BOARD, KUALA LUMPUR.—

Minutes of an ordinary meeting of the Sanitary Board, Kuala Lumpur, held at the Town Hall on Wednesday, the 3rd March, 1920, at 9.30 a.m.

PRESENT: Mr. F. E. Taylor (*Chairman*), the Health Officer (Dr. R. Bruce-Low), the Protector of Chinese (Mr. W. T. Chapman), the Government Architect (Major W. S. Huxley), the Chief Police Officer (Mr. D. Butler), the Superintendent, Revenue Surveys (Mr. H. R. Shaw), Mr. R. M. Skinner, Mr. R. Madge, Towkay Choo Kia Peng, J.P., Towkay Khoo Keng Hooi, Dr. E. T. MacIntyre and Haji Mohamed Taib.

ABSENT: The Collector of Land Revenue (Mr. G. Hemmant), the Executive Engineer, Town (Mr. J. A. Swift), and Mr. S. Mohideen Batcha.

1. Minutes of the previous meeting, having been circulated among the members, are taken as read, and confirmed.

2. Improvement Scheme, Foch Avenue: The proposed modification of the improvement scheme, Foch Avenue, by the deletion of that part of paragraph 4 (ii) after the word "lane" in second line which reads: "and the allocation of a strip, ten feet wide, of Cecil Street, along the southern boundary of lot 48, section 21, to such lot" is approved. The Board is prepared to consider plans of buildings for erection on lots 46, 47 and 48, section 21, without provision for a five-foot way along Cecil Street.

3. Improvement Scheme, Foch Avenue: Provided the owners submit a suitable plan for dealing with lots 70 and 71, section 21, jointly, the Board is prepared to recommend the following modifications of the Improvement Scheme, Foch Avenue—viz., the deletion of the whole of paragraph 4 (xi) which reads: "The acquisition of lots 70 and 71, section 21, by the State; the demolition of the houses thereon and the dedication of the land as an open space, to be put to such use as the 'Sanitary Board' thinks fit" and that part of paragraph 10 following the figures 36 in sixth line which reads: "but the Sanitary Board is of opinion that an open space at this spot to provide a site for hawkers and such like, which does not encroach on the public road is desired."

4. Appointment of Town Superintendent: The Board supports the recommendations of the Chairman for the appointment of a Town Superintendent for Kuala Lumpur, and urges that the appointment be made as early as possible.

5. Health Report: The Health Officer's report on the health of Kuala Lumpur for the month of January, 1920, is submitted:

(1) The population for the middle of January, 1920, is estimated at 67,186.

(2) Births: During the month, 122 births were notified, giving an uncorrected birth-rate of 21.79 per mille.

(3) Deaths: The total number of deaths registered as having occurred within the Sanitary Board limits was 204, giving a crude death-rate of 36.44 per mille. The number of deaths among the resident population was 157, giving a corrected death-rate of 28.04 per mille. The corrected death-rate for the corresponding month of 1919 was 31.85 per mille. There were 33 deaths of infants under the age of one year. The infantile mortality rate (deaths under one year of age per 1,000 births) was 270.49.

(4) The diseases causing the greatest number of deaths were:

(5) Infectious Diseases: Four cases of typhoid (enteric fever), two cases of chicken-pox and three cases of diphtheria were reported.

(6) The total rainfall recorded at the General Hospital for the month was 123.2 m.m. The greatest fall for the 24 hours ending 6 p.m. was 46 m.m. on the 10th. There was no recorded fall for 21 days. The mean temperatures for the month were: 9 a.m., 79.48 degrees; 3 p.m., 84.67 degrees; 9 p.m., 76.87 degrees. The maximum temperature was 92 degrees on the 8th and 24th, and the lowest was 70 degrees on the 3rd, 20th and 27th.

(7) Nine samples of milk were sent to the Government Chemist for analysis during the month, one of which was found to be adulterated.

6. Plans, Notices, Prosecutions, etc.:

- (a) Twenty-five plans as per register;
- (b) Ten applications for water supply;
- (c) Seventy-four notices and 107 applications for prosecutions;
- (d) Assessment of new houses as per register;
- (e) Progress report, Executive Engineer, Town, for January, 1920.
- (f) Water returns for period 1st to 16th January, 1920—

Owing to one of the meters being defective accurate figures of consumption cannot be given.
The daily average was, approximately, 2,431,000 gallons.

7. Schemes for Laying Out Lot 1, Section 40: Two alternative plans of a lay out of lot 1, section 40, Kuala Lumpur, are submitted. The Board approves the lay out of the blocks immediately facing Campbell Road as shown on plan No. 2, and appoints a Sub-Committee, consisting of the Chairman, Health Officer and Government Architect, to consider the remainder.

8. Mr. Choo Kia Peng, referring to the Kampong Malacca Improvement Scheme, suggests that, pending settlement of negotiations with regard to the acquisition of certain property, the State Engineer be asked to proceed with the construction of the bridge over the Klang River.
