No. 1704.—PRICE OF RUBBER.—

ORDER UNDER RULE 56 OF THE RULES UNDER.

No. 1705.—Whereas an outbreak of disease—*viz.*, foot-and-mouth disease—has occurred among cattle at Parit Buntar Quarantine Station, it is hereby ordered by the Resident of Perak that the importation of cattle into Perak via Parit Buntar is prohibited until further notice.

Notification No. 592, published in the *Gazette* of 2nd February, 1920, is amended accordingly.

RINDERPEST.

No. 1706.—Rinderpest having ceased to exist in the Settlement of Malacca, the Resident of Negri Sembilan hereby rescinds Notification No. 5031, published in the *Gazette* of the 12th December, 1919.
