APPOINTMENT OF JUDICIAL COMMISSIONER.

No. 2197.—In exercise of the powers in that behalf conferred on him by section 6 of "The Courts Enactment, 1918," and with the approval of the High Commissioner, the Chief Secretary to Government has appointed Mr. Justice F. C. A. Barrett Lennard, a Puisne Judge of the Colony of the Straits Settlements to be a Judicial Commissioner, Federated Malay States, with effect from the 28th May, 1920.

"THE MINERAL ORES ENACTMENT, 1915" (PAHANG).

No. 2198.—In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 1 of "The Mineral Ores Enactment, 1915," the Resident of Pahang appoints the first day of June, 1920, as the date upon which the said Enactment shall come into force throughout the State of

RINDERPEST.

No. 2199.--Information having been received that rinderpest exists among cattle at Port Swettenham Quarantine Station, in the Klang district, Selangor, the Resident of Perak, under rule 55 of the rules under "The Quarantine and Prevention of Disease Enactment, 1903," hereby prohibits the importation of cattle into the State of Perak from Klang district, Selangor, until further notice.

SWINE FEVER.

No. 2200.—Information having been received that swine fever exists among pigs in the Settlement of Malacca, the Resident of Pahang, under rule 55 of the rules under "The Quarantine and Prevention of Disease Enactment, 1903," prohibits the importation of pigs into the State of Pahang from Malacca, by land or sea, until further notice.

No. 2201.—Swine fever having ceased to exist among pigs in the State of Negri Sembilan, the Resident of Pahang hereby rescinds Notification No. 1698, published in the *Gazette* of the 8th June, 1917.
