“THE LABOUR CODE, 1912.”

No. 2202.—It is hereby notified that, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 156 of “The Labour Code, 1912,” the Indian Immigration Committee has, with the consent of the High Commissioner, prescribed the rate payable under section 156 (a) of the said Enactment to be six dollars per quarter for the third quarter of the year 1920.

No further rate under section 156 (b) of the said Enactment is prescribed in respect of the said quarter.

The number of working days comprised in the quarter has been fixed by the Indian Immigration Committee under section 160 (iv) (b) of the Labour Code for the third quarter of the year 1920 at 78 days.
