## REPORT ON THE WORK OF THE SUPREME COURT FOR THE YEAR 1920.

#### COURT OF APPEAL

#### CRIMINAL.

There were 51 criminal appeals during the year, of which 16 were summarily rejected, 21 were dismissed and 11 allowed, while in 3 cases the sentences were varied.

#### CIVIL.

There were 31 civil appeals during the year as against 36 in 1919.

#### COURT OF 'A JUDICIAL COMMISSIONER.

During the year, assizes for despatch of criminal work were held ten times in Kuala Lumpur and eleven times in Perak, and for the despatch of both criminal and civil business six times in Negri Sembilan, once in Kuala Lipis, three times in Bentong, and twice in Kuantan.

#### CRIMINAL.

There were 13 convictions for murder and 5 for gang-robbery with murder, as against 20 for murder for 1919. In five cases the sentence of death was carried out.

There were 180 convictions and 83 acquittals during the year as compared with 228 convictions and 83 acquittals in the previous year.

The figures for convictions show:

a decrease of 28 in Selangor;

37 ., Perak ;

1 " Negri Sembilan.

There were 165 appeals from Magistrates' decisions as against 231 in 1919: of these, 64 were allowed, 77 dismissed, in 14 cases the Magistrate's judgment was varied, and in 10 instances the case was returned to the lower Court.

#### CIVIL.

There were 1,111 suits entered in 1920 as against 995 in 1919.

The figures show:

an increase of 70 suits in Selangor;

a decrease of 35 " Perak;

an increase of 83 .. Negri Sembilan;

a decrease of 2 .. Pahang.

Petitions for probate and administration numbered 694 as compared with 917 in 1919.

There were 43 applications for execution of decrees of lower Courts as against 181 in 1919.

There were 81 civil appeals from Magistrates' decisions as compared with 63 in 1919.

#### REVENUE.

The total revenue collected in all four States amounted to \$52,027.09. The revenue collected in Selangor and Perak exceeded the estimated revenue by \$24,027.09.

#### GENERAL

Six hundred and four enquiries of death were held in 1920. A verdict of murder was returned in 66 cases, of culpable homicide in 5 cases, and of suicide in 60 cases.

During the year, 3,211 powers of attorney were registered; of these 1,530 were registered in Selangor, 1,112 in Perak, 276 in Negri Sembilan and 293 in Pahang.

#### STAFF.

Mr. E. A. Smith took over duties of Registrar from Mr. Rigby on 22nd January, 1920.

His Honour Mr. Justice Farrer-Manby officiated as Judicial Commissioner, Perak, from 1st to 7th January, 1920, Mr. Justice Brown from 8th January to 9th October, 1920, and Mr. Justice Watson officiated during the rest of the year. His Honour Mr. Justice Sproule officiated as Chief Judicial Commissioner from 29th March, 1920, to 10th October, 1920. Mr. G. Smith, Registrar, left for Penang on 17th June, 1920, Mr. R. M. McKenzie taking over duties of Registrar from that date up to 25th August, 1920.

The sad death of Mr. Justice Earnshaw at Ipoh on 19th March, 1920, while on duty has to be recorded.

Mr. Justice Watson took over the duties of Judicial Commissioner on 3rd August, 1920.

Mr. W. Burton officiated as Registrar from 26th August, 1920, to 20th October, 1920.

Mr. Justice Farrer-Manby officiated as Chief Judicial Commissioner from 11th October, 1920.

Mr. J. Rigby took over the duties of Registrar from Mr. Burton on 21st October, 1920.

Mr. Justice Whitley officiated as Judicial Commissioner, Kuala Lumpur, from 22nd December, 1920.
