- 14. The surplus of assets over liabilities at end of 1920 was reduced from \$109,926,017 to \$81,769,692, the expenditure for the year exceeding the revenue by \$28,156,325.
  - 15. A donation of \$125,000 was made towards the relief of the famine in China.
- 16. A sum of \$12,500,000 was charged off against expenditure in partial adjustment of advances made during the year on account of rice purchases.
- 17. Advances were also made in December on account of purchase of tin, the amount advanced up to the end of the year being \$4,578,325.
- 18. The sale of War Savings Certificates, which ceased on the 26th January, 1920, was resumed on the 1st September; and the number of certificates sold during the year was 5,580.
- 19. An instalment of £300,000 was paid to Siam on account of the Railway loan during the year, and the total amount paid up to 31st December, 1920, was £3,430,000.
- 20. Investments, which stood at (cost price) \$68,522,426 at end of 1919, were reduced to \$60,162,969 by the redemption during the year of 5 per cent. Exchequer Bonds for \$3,000,000, 6 per cent. Exchequer Bonds for \$5,142,857, and the repayment of \$,216,600 worth of Municipal Bonds.
