“THE LABOUR CODE, 1912.”

No. 7327.—It is hereby notified that, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 156 of “The Labour Code, 1912,” as amended by Enactment No. 31 of 1919, the Indian Immigration Committee has, with the consent of the High Commissioner, prescribed the rate payable under section 156 (a) of the said Enactment to be \$1 per quarter for the first quarter of the year 1923.

No further rate under section 156 (b) of the said Enactment is prescribed in respect of the said quarter.

The number of working days comprised in the quarter has been fixed by the Indian Immigration Committee under section 160 (iv) (b) of the Labour Code for the first quarter of the year 1923 at 78 days.
