“THE EXPORT OF RUBBER (RESTRICTION)  
ENACTMENT, 1923.”

No. 4745.—In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 7 of “The Export of Rubber (Restriction) Enactment, 1923,” the Chief Secretary to Government hereby declares that the authorized percentage for the quarter August 1st to October 31st, 1923, shall be 60 per centum.

“THE QUARANTINE AND PREVENTION OF DISEASE ENACTMENT, 1903.”

No. 4746.—Whereas the Resident of Negri Sembilan has received information that rabies exists at Bahau, in the district of Kuala Pilah, in the State of Negri Sembilan, he has ordered, in exercise of the powers vested in him by rule 89 of the rules under “The Quarantine and Prevention of Disease Enactment, 1903,” that all dogs out of doors in the administrative district of Kuala Pilah shall, until further notice, be muzzled or tied up or led on a chain.

No. 4747.—Whereas the Resident of Negri Sembilan has received information that rabies exists at Bahau, in the district of Kuala Pilah, in the State of Negri Sembilan, he has ordered, in exercise of the powers vested in him by rule 90 of the rules under “The Quarantine and Prevention of Disease Enactment, 1903,” that the exportation of any dogs from the administrative district of Kuala Pilah shall, until further notice, be absolutely prohibited.

No. 4748.—Information having been received that rabies exists among dogs in Bahau, district of Kuala Pilah, State of Negri Sembilan, it is hereby ordered by the Resident of Pahang, under section 90 (i) of the rules under “The Quarantine and Prevention of Disease Enactment, 1903,” that the importation of dogs into Pahang from Negri Sembilan is prohibited until further notice.
