A BILL

intituled

An Enactment to make Financial Provision for the Public Service for the year 1924.

W HEREAS the expenditure for the public service of the Federated Malay States for the year 1924 has been estimated at the sum of sixty million, one hundred and twenty-five thousand, four hundred and thirty-one dollars:

It is hereby enacted by the Rulers of the Federated Malay States in Council as follows:

- 1. This Enactment may be cited as "The Supply Enactment, 1923."
- 2. A sum not exceeding sixty million, one hundred and twenty-five thousand, four hundred and thirty-one dollars shall be and the same is hereby charged upon the revenues and other funds of the Federated Malay States for the public service of the year 1924 and the said sum so charged may be expended as specified in the schedule hereto:
