“THE QUARANTINE AND PREVENTION OF DISEASE ENACTMENT, 1903.”

No. 5430.—Information having been received that rinderpest exists among cattle at Batu Arang, the Resident of Perak, under rule 55 of the rules under “The Quarantine and Prevention of Disease Enactment, 1903,” hereby prohibits the importation of cattle into the State of Perak from the State of Selangor until further notice.

Exception—Cattle that have undergone 10 days’ quarantine in Port Swettenham quarantine station may be imported into Perak direct from Port Swettenham by train, if accompanied by a Veterinary Certificate. [Pk. 4008/25.]

RINDERPEST.

No. 5431.—The Resident of Negri Sembilan hereby rescinds Notification No. 4617, published in the *Federated Malay States Government Gazette* of the 8th October, 1920, prohibiting the importation of cattle from the Settlement of Malacca into the State of Negri Sembilan.

SWINE FEVER.

No. 5432.—The Resident of Negri Sembilan hereby rescinds Notification No. 2377, published in the *Federated Malay States Government Gazette* of the 11th June, 1919, prohibiting the importation of pigs from the Settlement of Malacca into the State of Negri Sembilan.
