### "THE LAND ACQUISITION ENACTMENT, 1922."

NOTIFICATION THAT LAND IS LIKELY TO BE NEEDED. [SECTION 4 (i).]

No. 7791.—It is hereby notified that it appears to the Resident of Perak that land in the locality hereunder described is likely to be needed for a work of public utility.

And it is further notified that the Collector of Land Revenue, Kuala Kangsar, and Sir W. G. Armstrong Whitworth and Company Limited and any servants or workmen employed under him or them are authorized by the Resident:

(i) To enter upon and survey and take levels of any land in the said locality;

(ii) To dig or bore into the sub-soil;

(iii) To do all other acts necessary to ascertain whether the land is adapted for such purpose;

(iv) To set out the boundaries of the land proposed to be taken and the intended line of the work proposed to be made thereon;

(v) To mark such levels, boundaries and lines by placing marks and cutting trenches;

(vi) Where otherwise the survey cannot be completed, the levels taken or the boundaries or line of work

Provided that no person shall enter into any building or upon any enclosed court or garden attached to a dwelling-house (unless with the consent of the occupier thereof) without previously giving such occupier at least seven days' notice in writing of his intention to do so.

DESCRIPTION OF APPROXIMATE LOCALITY.

The area enclosed between the parallels of  $4^{\circ}$  56' N. Lat. and  $5^{\circ}$  6' N. Lat. and  $100^{\circ}$  55' E. Long. and  $101^{\circ}$  1' E. Long.

The southern boundary is a line drawn east and west through the centre of Pulau Lallang crossing the Kuala Kangsar-Grik Road between the 31st and 32nd milestones.

The northern boundary is a line drawn west through a group of small islands in the Perak River a little upstream (approx. 1 mile) from Kampong Chepor, passing half a mile south of the hospital of Lenggong and crossing the Kuala Kangsar-Grik Road between the 46th and 47th milestones.

The eastern boundary is a line drawn southwards from the above-mentioned groups of islands. The western boundary is a line drawn north and south through Bukit Ulu Lanjut 3390 feet, which if prolonged hwards are boundary is a line drawn north and south through Bukit Ulu Lanjut 3390 feet, which if prolonged southwards crosses the Kuala Kangsar-Grik Road between the 30th and 31st milestones.
