QUARANTINE.

No. 283. -ORDINANCE NO. 157 (QUARANTINE AND PREVENTION OF DISEASE).

PLAGUE.—Information having been received that a dangerous infectious or contagious disease, namely, plague, exists in an epidemic state at Tanjong Balei, Karimon, it is hereby declared by His Excellency the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 48 of Ordinance No. 157 (Quarantine and Prevention of Disease), that the port of Tanjong Balei, Karimon, is an infected place for the purposes of the said Ordinance.
