No. 328.—ORDINANCE NO. 137 (FEDERATED MALAY STATES EXPORT DUTIES COLLECTION).

IN accordance with section 8 of the above Ordinance it is hereby notified for general information that Notification No. 117, published in the *Gazette* of 25th January, 1918, as amended by Notification No. 178, published in the *Gazette* of 8th February, 1918, Notification No. 379, published in the *Gazette* of 22nd March, 1918, Notification No. 88, published in the *Gazette* of 16th January, 1919, Notification No. 1829, published in the *Gazette* of 28th November, 1919, Notification No. 600, published in the *Gazette* of 1st April, 1920, Notification No. 1834, published in the *Gazette* of 18th November, 1921 and Notification No. 1835, published in the *Gazette* of 18th November, 1921, is further amended by deleting the words:—

“Rubber—

Any cultivated rubber (including latex”) and the items of export duty under that heading and by substituting therefor:—

Rubber—

Any cultivated rubber (including latex)

When the price of rubber as notified for the time being in the *Gazette* is 35 cents per pound or over but is under 37 cents per pound

... 1½ per cent of the value of rubber calculated at the price notified for the time being in the *Gazette*.

When the price of rubber as notified for the time being in the *Gazette* is 37 cents per pound or over but is under 38 cents per pound

... 1¾ per cent of the value of the rubber calculated at the price notified for the time being in the *Gazette*.

When the price of rubber as notified for the time being in the *Gazette* is 38 cents per pound or over but is under 39 cents per pound

... 2 per cent of the value of the rubber calculated at the price notified for the time being in the *Gazette*.

When the price of rubber as notified for the time being in the *Gazette* is 39 cents per pound or over but is under 40 cents per pound

... 2¼ per cent of the value of the rubber calculated at the price notified for the time being in the *Gazette*.

When the price of rubber as notified for the time being in the *Gazette* is 40 cents per pound or over (but is under \$1.50 per pound)

... 2½ per cent of the value of the rubber calculated at the price notified for the time being in the *Gazette*.

When the price of rubber as notified for the time being in the *Gazette* is \$1.50 per pound or over

... 3 per cent of the value of the rubber calculated at the price notified for the time being in the *Gazette*.

For the purposes of this Notification one gallon of latex shall be taken as equivalent to one pound of rubber, and bark shavings from rubber trees shall be taken to contain 20 per cent by weight of rubber.

No. 329.—THE LABOUR ORDINANCE, 1920.

IT is hereby notified that, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 133 of the Labour Ordinance, 1920, the Indian Immigration Committee has, with the consent of His Excellency the Governor, prescribed the rate payable under section 133 (i) (a) of the said Ordinance to be fifty cents per quarter for the second quarter of the year 1922.

No further rate under section 133 (i) (b) of the said Ordinance is prescribed in respect of the said quarter.

The number of working days comprised in the quarter has been fixed by the Indian Immigration Committee under section 137 (iv) (b) of the said Ordinance for the second quarter of the year 1922 at 78 days. [No. 1577/22.]
