No. 947.—The Right Hon'ble the Secretary of State for the Colonies has notified His Excellency the Officer Administering the Government that HIS MAJESTY THE KING will not be advised to exercise his power of disallowance with respect to the following Ordinances:-

No. 27 of 1921.—An Ordinance to control dealings in rubber. [No. 4405/22.] No. 8 of 1922.—An Ordinance to impose Restrictions on Aliens. [No. 4402/22.]

No. 948.—ORDINANCE No. 136 (ARMS AND EXPLOSIVES).

Rule 28 of the Rules made by the Governor in Council under section 36 of the Arms and Explosives Ordinance, 1913, (corresponding to section 35 of Ordinance No. 136 (Arms and Explosives)) and published as Notification No. 1554 in the Gazette of the 13th December, 1913, is amended by adding at the end thereof the following words:-

"And provided further that no fee shall be charged for a licence to possess a revolver belonging to an Army Reserve Officer'

No. 949. -ORDINANCE NO. 27 (FEES).

ORDER RESPECTING QUARANTINE CERTIFICATES.

WHEREAS by section 2 of Ordinance No. 27 (Fees), it is among other things provided that it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to fix tables of fees leviable or to be leviable in all public offices and departments in the Colony:

AND WHEREAS it appears to the Governor in Council expedient that fees be fixed to be leviable in respect of the granting by the Port Health Officer, Singapore and Penang, of certificates of quarantine to pilgrims;

Now, THEREFORE, it is ordered by the Governor in Council that the following fee shall be leviable in the department of the Port Health Officer, Singapore and Penang :-

For granting a certificate to a pilgrim from the Hedjaz to the effect that he and his family have undergone quarantine.....50 cents.

Notification No. 168, published in the Gazette of the 9th February, 1912, is hereby cancelled.

The Astronomical positions are only approximate unless seconds are given. The bearings are given both True and Magnetic, and those relating to lights are from seaward. The visibility of lights is that in clear weather. Fog signals are sounded only in thick or foggy weather. The elevation given is the height of fecal plane above high water.







No. 915.—The following Bill about to be introduced in the Legislative Council is published tfor general information :-

#### A BILL

#### intituled

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 64 (Defence Contribution).

It is hereby enacted by the Governor of the Straits Settlements with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:-

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as Ordinance No. 64 Short title. (Defence Contribution) Amendment Ordinance, 1922.
- 2. Section 4 of Ordinance No. 64 (Defence Contribution), Amendment hereinafter called the principal Ordinance, is repealed of section 4. and the following section is substituted therefor:-
  - 4.—(1) In the first instance the Colony shall pay into Payment on the Imperial Treasury Chest in the Colony on account of defence account of His Majesty's Government either a contribution. sum equal to twenty per centum of its estimated revenue or a sum equal to the estimated cost of the garrison for the year, whichever of these two sums is the less.

(2) If the payment made under sub-section (1) is Adjustment greater than the amount payable under this of account. Ordinance, the excess shall be refunded to the Colony by His Majesty's Government, but if the payment made under sub-section (1) is less than the amount payable under this Ordinance, the deficiency shall be paid by the Colony into the Imperial Treasury Chest in the Colony on account of His Majesty's Government.

3. Section 6 of the principal Ordinance is amended by Amendment deleting the words "The said percentage" and substituting of section 6. therefor the words "One-twelfth of the amount payable under section 4 (1)".

#### OBJECTS AND REASONS.

Under the existing law the Colony has in the first instance to pay as Defence Contribution 20 per cent of its estimated assessable revenue. It then has to pay 20 per cent of the difference between its estimated and actual revenue. It is, however, provided that the sums so paid by the Colony shall not exceed the actual cost of the garrison. Should there be such an excess payment, the Colony may have to wait a very considerable time before a refund of this excess is made. This Bill is introduced to reduce such delay to a minimum.
