QUARANTINE.

No. 984.—ORDINANCE NO. 157 (QUARANTINE AND PREVENTION OF DISEASE).

CHOLERA.—Information having been received that a dangerous infectious or contagious disease, namely, cholera, exists in an epidemic state at Saigon, it is hereby declared by His Excellency the Officer Administering the Government, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 48 of Ordinance No. 157 (Quarantine and Prevention of Disease), that the port of Saigon is an infected place for the purposes of the said Ordinance. No. 985.—ORDINANCE NO. 157 (QUARANTINE AND PREVENTION OF DISEASE).

SMALL-POX.—Information having been received that a dangerous infectious or contagious disease, namely, small-pox, exists in a sporadic state at Saigon, it is hereby declared by His Excellency the Officer Administering the Government, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 48 of Ordinance No. 157 (Quarantine and Prevention of Disease), that the port of Saigon is a suspected place for the purposes of the said Ordinance.
