“THE LABOUR CODE, 1912, AMENDMENT  
ENACTMENT, 1913 (No. 2).”

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 1 (i) of “The Labour Code, 1912, Amendment Enactment, 1913 (No. 2),” the Chief Secretary to Government hereby appoints the 1st day of May, 1914, as the date on which section 5 and paragraph *b* (2) of section 6 of “The Labour Code, 1912, Amendment Enactment, 1913 (No. 2),” shall come into force throughout the Federated Malay States.

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No. 1174.—FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE.—ORDER UNDER RULE 55 OF “THE QUARANTINE AND PREVENTION OF DISEASE ENACTMENT, 1903.”—In exercise of the powers vested in him by rule 55 of the Rules under “The Quarantine and Prevention of Disease Enactment, 1903,” the Resident of Selangor hereby orders that the importation of cattle into Selangor from Negapatam and Madras is prohibited until further notice.
